Nursery accommodations are available for children age birth through preschool in Minnie's Place. Childcare is available for youth in grades one through five in High 5. Advance reservations are required for both areas and flyers are available with listed times for childcare. All progressive and learn to swim classes for youth are included at no additional charge with family memberships.

What are the advantages of membership payment by monthly bank draft?

There are no contracts. Members complete an authorization form for drafting pre-authorized fees for monthly membership payment. Members using the bank draft plan are never again invoiced for dues but still may terminate their membership draft at any time **with a thirty-day notice**. Because the membership is perpetual, a termination request card must be signed for the draft to be stopped. Should a draft not be honored by one's bank for any reason, the member is responsible for the payment plus a returned handling fee to **Debt-Check Recovery Systems**, a collection agent.

Always Welcome At the YMCA

Don't leave home without your YMCA membership card. Upon request, an AWAY sticker can be affixed to the back of a YMCA membership card and will grant you entrance to most YMCAs across the country. Ask Membership Services for your AWAY card and be ready for your next out of town trip. If you are interested in visiting other YMCA's often, please inquire about CC Membership.

Our Guest Policy

Members are encouraged to bring guests. Adult members are allotted **two guest passes per year** to use for visitors. Youth members are not allotted guest passes. Adult members who bring youth guests (under 18) must remain with them at all times. Please inquire at the desk when bringing out of town family members. Passes are available from the membership desk.

To ensure the Safety of All Guests:

- Each guest must sign the guest register and surrender their guest pass.
- Members are responsible for the behavior and safety of their guests.
- Youth must be **18 and out of high school** in order to enter the adult fitness area.

Financial Assistance Policy

The YMCA's Financial Assistance Policy and Plan was implemented in 1987. Through this plan, a sliding fee scale for programs and memberships are available based on need. Assistance may be obtained by completing an application (available from the membership desk). **Total family income must be verified annually**. Proof of income must be submitted with application and the Executive Director will review this documentation. Friends of the YMCA and United Way make assistance possible by charitable contributions to the annual Sustaining Membership Campaign.
