WELCOME CampERS!

The staff of Camp TSN is excited that your preschooler will be part of our summer experience. Our goal is to help all campers grow physically, mentally and spiritually in a Christian-based camp through fun and challenging activities led by caring, trained staff.

ENROLLMENT: All campers must be between the ages of three and five and potty-trained. **There must be a minimum of 10 campers for each session; early registration is very helpful.**

STAFF

Parents may leave their children at Camp TSN each day knowing that they will be taken care of by qualified, trained staff. Kelley Bigger, Family Services Director, supervises all summer camps. Camp TSN will be led by Ronda Bunn and Cathy Little. Both camp leaders have extensive work history within the YMCA and child care.

FACILITIES

Conference Room #2, YMCA park, lots of outdoor running space, two indoor gyms, racquetball courts, indoor swimming pool, and chapel.

ACTIVITIES

Each week will have a different theme which will, of course serve as the guide for the activities. Regular activities, however, will include games, center time, group time, arts and crafts, devotions, swimming, music, supervised free time, playground time, special visitors, lunch and snacks.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration for camp will begin April 28th. Registration will not be accepted without a completed form and first installment. **All children must be registered by June 15th.** A waiting list will be taken after this date. It is imperative that camp staff has the correct information on each child.

THINGS TO BRING/NOT TO BRING TO CAMP

Each day children should bring a drink and lunch box that is clearly labeled. Children should dress as any artist, chef or athlete would. We ask that campers not bring toys or any other games from home. We cannot be responsible for lost or broken items.



SWIM TIMES

Campers will swim on Wednesdays from noon-1:00 p.m. This will be a recreational swim time. The Aquatics Department will provide a lifeguard and the camp staff will swim with the children. Please be sure to pack a bathing suit and towel each Wednesday.

RATE POLICIES

FIRST INSTALLMENT

\$10.00 per session/per child

This first installment will be deducted from the weekly fee.

This fee is due upon registration and is non-refundable. ***Registration entitles each child to one free t-shirt.**

PAYMENTS

All payments are due by Friday for the next week. Parents may pay at the Membership Desk with checks (payable to the Stanly County Family YMCA), credit card or cash. Please write your child's first and last name and the week you are paying for on the memo line of your check. Any credit card payments can be accepted either in person or by phone. A \$5.00 late fee will be charged for all payments made later than Friday.

Families with two or more children participating in our program will receive a \$5.00 sibling discount for each session.

\$65.00 per session

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

1. In order to campers to get the total TSN experience, please be sure to drop off and pick up your child on time.
2. It is essential that staff has correct information on each child. Parents are responsible for providing current information including emergency phone numbers and those allowed to pick-up each child.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

The YMCA wants every child to enjoy the activities planned and benefit from their experience at the YMCA. Rules and consequences will be explained to the children. They are as follows:

Rules

1. Follow directions.
2. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
3. Use courteous manners-no name calling or teasing.
4. Never leave your group without permission.

Praise

Praise, Positive notes, Special privileges, and Recognition be

Consequences

1. Warning
2. Activity will be restricted
3. Time out
4. Talk w/ parents upon pick-up
5. Conference w/ parent
6. If behavior does not change, child may dismissed.

The YMCA does not condone the following: any use of corporal punishment, making fun of, threatening or yelling at children, using profanity in front of children, or leaving children unsupervised.

LOST ARTICLES

PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING!!! Unclaimed articles will be placed in our storage tubs. Parents may check at any time for lost items. All articles not claimed will be taken to the Stanly Community Clothing Closet at the end of the summer.

MEDICATION POLICY

Camp Staff cannot be responsible for administering any medication.



ILLNESSES

The YMCA cannot provide care to sick children. Please do not send your ranch hand to camp if he/she has a temperature of 100 degrees or higher, or if your child has vomited in the last 24 hours. The staff will call and ask you to pick up your child if he/she becomes ill while at camp.

RETURNED CHECKS

You will be notified should a check be returned due to "insufficient funds". A \$30.00 service fee will be charged for any returned check. After two returned checks, we will accept cash or money orders only. Should you at any time have a financial problem, immediately contact Kelley Bigger, Family Services Director.

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

Roll call will be taken each morning at 8:30. Please walk with your child up to Conference Room #2 and check in with camp staff. If your child will not be attending camp for the day, please call and notify our staff.

For their protection, your child will only be released to those persons listed on their registration form. Anyone picking up your child must know the family password, which must be listed on his/her registration form. If the child is to leave with someone other than those listed, parents must notify the staff in writing.



LATE PICK-UP

Camp ends promptly at 12:00 p.m. If you arrive later, you will be required to pay an additional fee of \$10.00 for each 15-minute increment that staff must wait with your child. This payment is to be made at the desk upon

pick-up.

CANCELLATIONS

Parents are responsible for payments for each session registered unless the camp staff receives a completed "Schedule Change Form" one week prior to that session. At that time, parents are only responsible for 50% of the remainder of the weekly fee (the first installment is non-refundable).
